

# STAIRCASE MEASURING GUIDE

## for Straight Stairlifts

**IMPORTANT: It is imperative that all measurements provided are accurate and complete.** AmeriGlide relies exclusively on the measurements submitted by the customer when designing, manufacturing, and scheduling installation of the stairlift. If any measurement is inaccurate and prevents installation from being completed during the initial appointment, a \$300 return trip fee will be charged. In addition, the customer shall be responsible for any costs associated with additional service visits, replacement parts, rail modifications, re-manufacturing, shipping, or labor resulting from inaccurate measurements.

### 1. Overall Length

ft. / in.

Stand at the top of your stairs, extend your tape measure until it is laying on all the stair treads and the tip of the tape measure is touching the landing at the bottom of the steps.

### 2. Top Stair to Bottom Stair

ft. / in.

Stand at the top of your stairs, extend your tape measure until it is touching the edge of the bottom step.

### 3. Staircase Width

ft. / in.

Measure the width of your staircase and enter the measurement.

### 4. Bottom Clearance

ft. / in.

If there is a wall or a door at the bottom of the steps, measure from the bottom step to the wall.

### 5. Rise of One Step

ft. / in.

Measure from the top of a step to the very next step down.

### 6. Tread Depth

ft. / in.

Measure from the front of one step to the front of the kickplate.

### 7. Diagonal

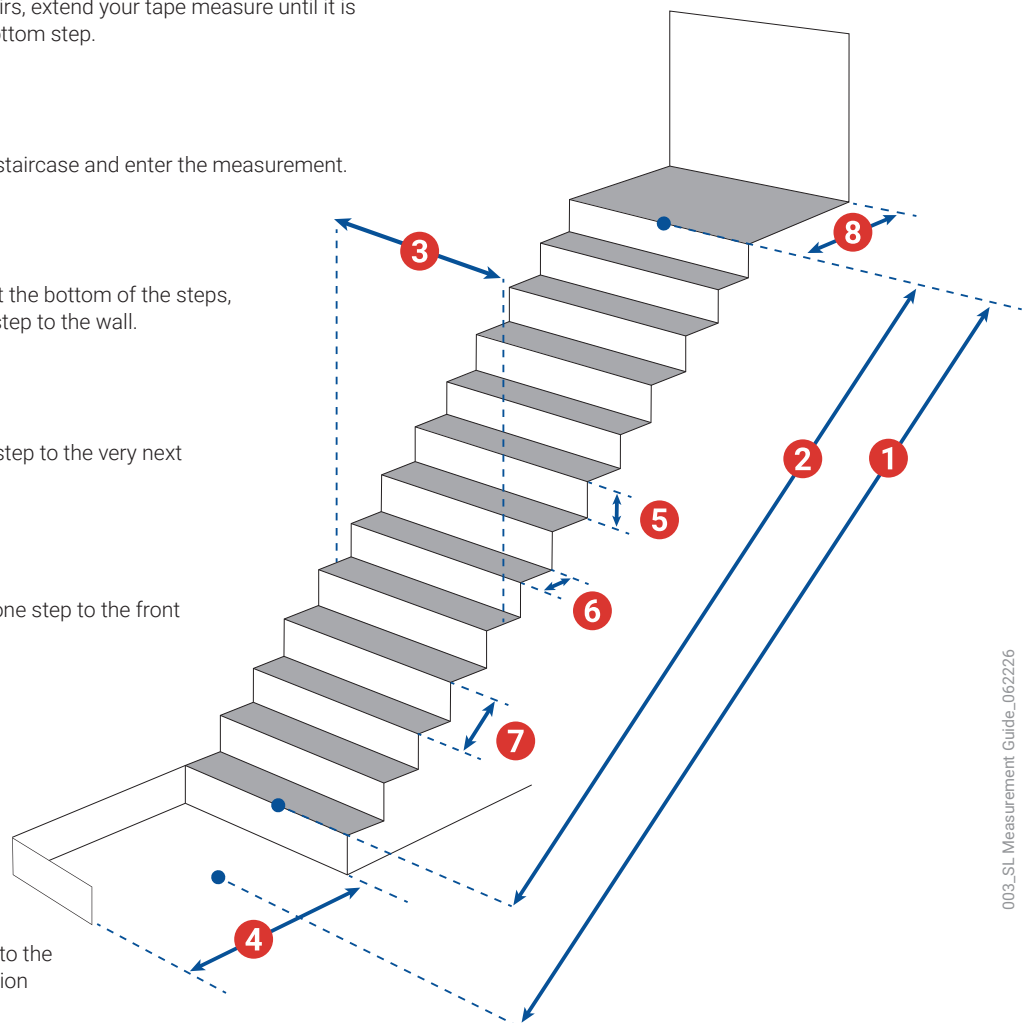
ft. / in.

Measure from the front of one step to the front of the next step down.

### 8. Top Clearance

ft. / in.

Measure from the top step to the door, wall, or other obstruction at the top of the stairs.
